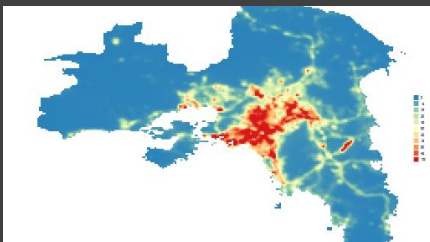




## BIODIVERSITY OF THE CITY
